Full-time employed persons averaged 85 hours of work time on weekdays they worked, and 54 hours on weekend days they worked Multiple jobholders were more likely to work on an average weekend day than were single jobholders—56 percent, compared with 28 percent These and other results from the American Time Use Survey (ATUS) were released
